CONDITIONS OF TENDERING/QUOTATION

Quotations shall be submitted via Vendor Panel only.

Supplier shall note that the lowest or any quotation may not necessarily be accepted.

The supplier is to ensure RFQ responses issued under their own hand are individually itemised and cost all components associated with the supply of the vehicle. RFQ responses issued which do not conform may be returned by the Purchaser to the issuing Vendor to reformat and resubmit to the Purchaser. This requires the Contractor to individually list all requested accessories, details of the cab chassis and available options, body configuration, pre-delivery, vehicle movements, extended warranty options and training being offered.

QUOTATION COMPONENTS TO BE SUPPLIED BY CONTRACTOR

The contractor must supply the following as part of their complete quotation to council.

1. Expected delivery date
2. RFQ is to be fully completed to be accepted
3. Brochures of proposed machine
4. A complete detailed Quotation

<p>Vehicle:</p> <p>Vehicle shall be suitable for the harsh conditions and required work in our shire.</p> <p>Vehicle will need to be road train rated to a minimum of 105T.</p>		
<p>Engine:</p> <p>Engine is to be a Cummins with a minimum engine power of 550Hp. A minimum torque rating of 1850lb-ft at 1200 rpm</p> <p>AdBlu and DPF systems accepted.</p> <p>Engine Cooling pack is to be suitable for extreme ambient temperatures.</p> <p>Engine Air filtration system is to be of a sufficient standard as to cope with harsh environments.</p>		
<p>Bulbar:</p> <p>A Bullbar is to be fitted that is of sufficient strength to last in regional conditions.</p> <p>2 x LED spotlights (Minimum 7") are to be fitted to the bulbar and wired to the truck.</p> <p>Two piece Roadtrain signs and covers are to be fitted to the bulbar.</p>		
<p>Cabin:</p> <p>The cabin shall be lockable, pressurised, weather proof and fitted with fully integrated air conditioning unit with heater/demister. The cabin shall be fitted with front and rear washer/wiper units, an air operated or hydraulic cloth upholstered seat adjustable to suit the weight of individual operators shall be provided. The seat shall be fitted with a canvas seat cover.</p> <p>A Fridge is to be mounted inside the cab, 30L Minimum.</p>		
<p>Cabin Tinting:</p> <p>The cabin window glass will be tinted to the maximum legal limit as per QLD Department of Transport Regulations.</p>		

<p>Cabin Filtration:</p> <p>The operator cabin will have removable/ replaceable air conditioning filters</p>

<p>Spare Wheel:</p> <p>A complete spare wheel with fitted tyre shall be supplied.</p>		

<p>A Spare Tyre Carrier is to be fitted to the vehicle and in a location that allows for easy removal and fitment of spare tyre, without compromising the use of the vehicle.</p>		
<p>Engine Filtration:</p> <p>The air filter system shall consist of a dry element type outer filter with an inner safety filter and a cyclone type pre cleaner.</p>		
<p>Lighting: ALL LED LIGHTS(except Headlights)</p> <p>The vehicle shall be supplied with the necessary lights for night time and on road operation.</p> <p>Lights are to be fitted at the rear of cab for night time working and operated from the cab.</p>

This is to include the specifics of the training. i.e. Classroom lead courses, Manufacturer training, branch lead training etc.</p>

<p>Risk Management Plan Supplied:</p> <p>The successful supplier must ensure the plant is constructed to be safe and without risk when operated properly, and that the plant has undergone appropriate testing and examination, and that reasonable steps have been undertaken to ensure that the appropriate information is supplied.</p>		
<p>Registration:</p> <p>The vehicle shall be registered prior to delivery to the Murweh Shire Council Depot. The vehicle will require registration to the councils common due date of 01/01/2021</p>		
<p>Warranty:</p> <p>The vehicle supplied shall be provided with manufacturer's warranty and an offer for extended warranty.</p>		
<p>Risk Assessments:</p> <p>Machine risk assessments are to be supplied.</p>		

EXTRA ITEMS REQUIRED – Hire Until 20-21 Financial Year

As the Murweh Shire Council would like to purchase this machine in the 21/22 financial year, but as the MSC has had a major failure on other plant, the MSC would like to enter into a hire arrangement until the new financial year. This tender document would be a commitment to purchase the vehicle from the tender victor, after the financial year.

As such, if the machine delivery would be before the financial year, the MSC would like hire the quoted vehicle until the new financial year, at which such time it would be purchased outright.

Please supply a quote for the hire rate of the quoted vehicle that is for the period of expected delivery until the start of the new financial year.

A full list of hire and purchase terms and conditions are to be supplied as part of this tender.

SERVICING AUTHORISATION

One of the key selection criteria will be the ability of the supplier to offer after sales support by way of ongoing servicing of the vehicle (as defined under the manufacturers log) as well as a support service for breakdown maintenance.

During the warranty period the supplier is to ensure that any breakdown or unavailability of this machine for Council's operations which are greater than 5 working days is unacceptable and will require the supplier to provide a similar type vehicle in good working order until such time as the Council's vehicle is returned (the supply of this loan vehicle will be at no cost to Council other than running costs for fuel). If Council enters into a service agreement post the warranty period it would be looking to establish similar conditions (free loan vehicle for period greater than 5 days).
