The 2024 Australia Day Awards recognise Murweh's unsung heroes. The awards pay tribute to the special people in our community who have gone above and beyond to help improve the lives of others and contribute to a diverse, friendly and strong community.

This special person could be your neighbour, a friend or someone you have come across through your local school, church or sporting group. Whoever comes to mind, they are someone who works selflessly to help improve your life and the lives of others.

The efforts of these quiet achievers can often go unnoticed in our busy lives. The Australia Day Awards are about taking the time to ensure these remarkable individuals are honoured and receive the recognition they deserve.

Categories

Citizen of the Year (open age)

Celebrating people who have given outstanding service to the local community or achievement during the current year or over several years.

Young Citizen of the Year

Eligible nominees must be 25 years or younger as of 26 January 2024. Celebrating young people who have significantly achieved and/or given outstanding volunteer service to the local community.

Sports Award

In recognition of a person or team who have an outstanding record of achievement in sport and who have served as noteworthy ambassadors for their sport at regional, state or international level.

Junior Sports Award

Eligible nominees must be 25 years or younger as of 26 January 2024. In recognition of a young person or team who have an outstanding record of achievement in sport and who have served as noteworthy ambassadors for their sport in regional, state or international level.

Community Event or Organisation of the Year

This award is presented to an organisation that has made a substantial contribution to the community or Event that has provided an outstanding contribution to the community during 2023.

Arts, Culture and/or Environmental Award of the Year

This award is in recognition of a person or group who have made a noteworthy contribution to the cultural life in the Murweh Shire or an outstanding achievement in an arts or cultural activity OR in recognition of a person or group who have contributed significantly to the environmental preservation or advancing environmental awareness in Murweh Shire.
