## **Part 1 Preliminary**

### **1 Short title**

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Subordinate Local Law No. 1.12 (Operation of Temporary Entertainment Events) 2012*.

### **2 Purpose and how it is to be achieved**

- (1) The purpose of this subordinate local law is to supplement *Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2012* which provides for a legal and procedural framework for the administration, implementation and enforcement of the local government's local laws, subordinate local laws and other regulatory powers, and for miscellaneous administrative matters.
- (2) The purpose is to be achieved by providing for—
  - (a) various matters regarding the granting of approvals for prescribed activities; and
  - (b) further specification of the definitions relevant to various prescribed activities.
- (3) In particular, the purpose of this subordinate local law is to supplement the legal and procedural framework for the prescribed activity named in schedule 1, section 1.

### **3 Authorising local law**

The making of the provisions in this subordinate local law is authorised by *Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2012* (the **authorising local law**).

## **Part 2 Approval for prescribed activity**

### **4 Matters regarding the prescribed activity—Authorising local law, ss 6(3)**

- (1) Schedule 1—
  - (a) names a prescribed activity in section 1; and
  - (b) prescribes the matters specified in this section for the prescribed activity.
- (2) For section 6(3) of the authorising local law, it is declared that section 6(2) of the authorising local law does not apply to the particular activity stated in section 2 of schedule 1.
